INTRODUCTION

Axedale is a growing township with a strong sense of community, enhanced by the natural beauty of the Campaspe River which winds through the heart of the locality. Axedale continues to attract new residents and families who are choosing to live here as they have easy access to Melbourne and to the thriving regional centre of Bendigo as well as the peace of the district.

This is Axedale's fourth community plan. Axedale Our Town - Our Future has led implementation of previous plans and the community has benefitted a great deal from the initiatives that have been undertaken. Once again Axedale Our Town -Our Future has taken the lead in reviewing and renewing the plan, drawing on input and feedback from community members.

The population of the Axedale locality has grown from 571 in 2011 to 984 in 2021 and at we need to develop our community facilities to better meet the needs of our growing community.

This plan has a focus on demonstrating the need and seeking broad support for a community hub in Axedale to enhance sporting facilities for the growing community and to complement existing assets. This will be a major project for Axedale.

We hope the community will be actively involved at each stage of this exciting initiative and other projects.
